## Free vs. Pro


### **Free**


- 100 MB photos per month
  - You can't recover space by deleting
- Photostream views limited to the 200 most recent images
- 2 videos per month
- Post any of your photos in up to 10 group pools
- Only smaller (resized) images accessible (though the originals are saved in case you upgrade later)


### Pro

- Unlimited photo uploads (20MB per photo)
- **Unlimited** video uploads (90 seconds max, 500MB per video)
- The ability to show **HD Video**
- Unlimited storage
- Unlimited bandwidth
- Post any of your photos or videos in up to 60 group pools
- Archiving of high-resolution original images
- The ability to **replace a photo**
- Ad-free browsing and sharing
- View count and referrer statistics


