**If you're ready** for something completely different, this team event will be it. The following summary previews how the game will work and hopefully will encourage people to start forming teams and thinking about how to approach odd-ball photo assignments.

**Teams must include** at least one CPS member apiece, plus however many guests they choose to bring along. They will meet at the **CPS clubroom** at the appointed date and time. Each team will be given a listing of possible subjects and

some 35mm Polaroid instant slide film. Each subject is worth some **points** with some being more valuable than others. Multiple subjects may be included in one image, so combine as many subjects as you can!

**Each team can take** as many photographs as their film and time will allow, but no more than 8 can be entered in the competition. We will meet back at the Clubroom in the afternoon for film processing and slide mounting. Food and beverages will be served. The viewing and scoring of the teams chosen entries will then be the evening's finale.

**Each person must pay** an entry fee of \$7.00, to cover food, drinks and prizes. Each team also has to pay for their own film. Bring as much equipment as you want, but remember that damage, wear, traffic violations and other mishaps, are your own responsibility. 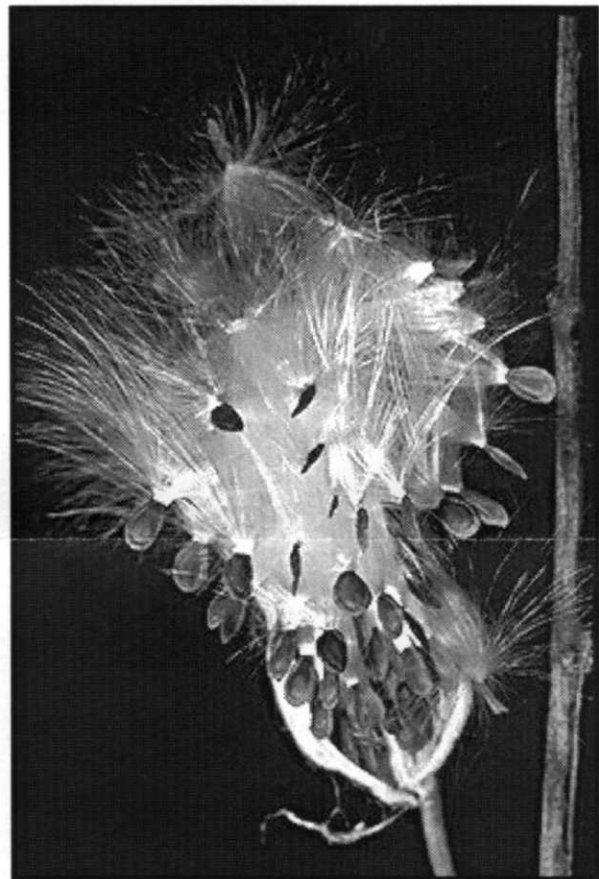
